# ONYCHOMYCOSIS PRE & POST CARE



#### PRE-TREATMENT CARE

- Check with your technician if you are on any photosensitive medications (medications making you more sensitive to light)
- Self tanner, tanning beds, and anything else that can change the colour of your skin cannot be used 2 weeks prior to treatment
- Fungus grows in a moist, dark environment and can spread from person to person. Ensure you are wearing clean footwear at public pools & showers.
- Ensure you are not sharing foot products, like nail files or nail clippers.
- Look into the candida diet. Nail fungus is a yeast (like all funguses) and can be proliferated by excess candida. The basics of this are: no nightshade vegetables, no dairy, no simple carbs
- Invest in one or more of the following:
  - o topical tea tree oil (external)
  - o oil of oregano (internal)
  - food grade peroxide cleanse (internal)
  - ClenZyme (available at Nature's Fare)
  - Dettol for sanitation of clothing, shoes, bedsheets, etc.
  - Bleach for all white items
  - Powder anti-fungal for runners & any other shoes that will be sweat in or wear regularly
  - o Footlogix Sweaty Foot Formula
- Consider a Live Blood Analysis appointment (Highly recommended)

#### THE DAY OF

- Arrive to your appointment with the treatment area free of nail polish, lotions, tanning products, numbing creams, etc.
- Avoid any activities that will increase the body temperature for at least 2 hours before and after treatments
- Take Tylenol 45 minutes prior to treatment (optional)
- If you have any residual self tanner, ensure you remove it prior to treatment, it WILL burn
- Bring fresh socks/shoes to change into for post treatment

### POST-TREATMENT CARE

- Discomfort (heat) is possible for the following hour or two
- Ensure everywhere you are is sanitized. Consider indoor shoes that can be sanitized daily, this will minimize cross contamination from floors.
- Consider those you live with are they at risk for cross contamination?
- The hardest part of nail fungus is reinfection. What have your toes touched in the past that they will touch post treatment? Ensure all surfaces are sanitized.

## POST-TREATMENT CARE

- Schedule treatments 2 weeks apart
- If you experience any side effects to this treatment that you are unsure of, or that have not been explained to you, contact Odette's Clinic immediately with pictures (if applicable)
- Follow up session may be done 6 months after last session at 50% off
